RE: 2011 AFSCME Family Scholarship

We are pleased to announce the AFSCME Family Scholarship Program for the year 2011 for children of full dues paying AFSCME members. Under the program, ten (10) scholarships of \$2,000 will be awarded to each winner selected from the applications which meet the eligibility requirements.

The scholarships will be renewed for \$2,000 each year for a maximum of four years, provided the student remains enrolled in a full-time degree program at an accredited institution. The scholarship may be used for any field of study.

To be eligible for a scholarship the student must:

- Be a graduating high school senior whose parent, legal guardian or financially responsible grandparent is a full dues paying AFSCME member;
- Be enrolled in a full-time degree program either at an accredited four-year institution or at a two-year institution that will transfer credits to a four-year institution;
- Have taken the SAT or the ACT.

Family Scholarship Program

AFSCME is currently accepting applications for the 2011 Family Scholarship Program. Ten scholarships of \$2,000 each will be awarded annually and renewed each year for a maximum of four years, and may be used for any field of study. Applications must be postmarked by December 31, 2010.

To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a graduating high school senior whose parent, legal guardian or financially responsible grandparent is a full dues-paying AFSCME member.
- Be enrolled in a full-time degree program either at an accredited four-year institution or at a two-year institution that will transfer credits to a four-year institution.
- Have taken the SAT or the ACT.
